Program/Entertainment is an important part of every camp, and Windy Gap wants to facilitate that area as much as possible. We can help with ideas and logistics; we have a limited prop room. However, to actually do the program, we recommend that the Camp Manager arrange and put together a program team.

A typical program team would consist of a Speaker, Lead Program Director, a Program Assistant and a Program Technician to handle the sound and A/V needs. If your group does not have a program team, it is still imperative that you designate someone to serve as the operator of all of the sound, lighting and A/V equipment that you may use. Our staff will be available to train your operator on the various equipment and systems, but will not be available to serve as program tech for your camp.

THE PROGRAM TEAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Bringing any special props, music, etc. for use during the group's stay at camp.
- Transporting equipment to and from activities and events.
- Cleaning up all program materials after activities/events (e.g., water balloons, balls, cones, flour bombs, etc.).
- Cleaning the sound room, prop room, stage, and any other program areas before leaving camp.
- Pre-camp Communication with Windy Gap: The program director should be in communication with Windy Gap a minimum of two weeks prior to camp.
- The program team needs to arrive two hours ahead of the main camp in order to be trained and to cover any last minute details.
